as a result of a diabetic foot ulcer




In 2016, 460,000 **British Columbians** were living with diabetes



5,000 to 8,300 had a diabetic foot ulcer



Nearly **590** had an amputation below the knee



Direct health-care costs:

Up to \$120 million a year







What can we do? In addition to improved screening and foot care, increased government funding for specialized devices can help prevent amoutations and save our health-care system up to \$23 million a year.
