1 amputation every 32 hours






In 2017, 126,000 **Manitobans** were living with diabetes



1,400 to **2,400** had a diabetic foot ulcer



Nearly **270** had an amputation below the knee



Direct health-care costs:

Up to \$35 million a year







What can we do? In addition to improved screening and foot care, increased government funding for specialized devices can help prevent amputations and save our health-care system up to \$9.1 million a year.
