
Why action is needed to prevent amputations in New Brunswick

In New Brunswick, there is

1 amputation every 73 hours

as a result of a diabetic foot ulcer



In 2017, 90,000 people in New Brunswick were living with diabetes



1,000 to **1,700** had a diabetic foot ulcer



Nearly **120** had an amputation below the knee



Direct health-care costs:

Up to \$25 million a year







What can we do? In addition to improved screening and foot care, increased government funding for specialized devices can help prevent amoutations and save our health-care system up to \$4.7 million a year.
