
Why action is needed to prevent amputations in Newfoundland and Labrador

as a result of a diabetic foot ulcer






In 2018, 65,000 people in NL are living with diabetes



760 to **1,260** will have a diabetic foot ulcer



Nearly **160** will have an amputation below the knee



Direct health-care costs:

Up to \$18 million a year







What can we do? In addition to improved screening and foot care, increased government funding for specialized devices can help prevent amoutations and save our health-care system up to \$5.2 million a year.
