## In 2015, 1.5 million **Ontarians were** living with diabetes

as a result of a diabetic foot ulcer



**16,600** to **27,600** had a diabetic foot ulcer



Nearly 2,000 had an amputation below the knee



Direct health-care costs:

Up to \$400 million a year







What can we do? In addition to improved screening and foot care, increased government funding for specialized devices can help prevent amoutations and save our health-care system up to \$75 million a year.

In 2017, the Government of Ontario announced \$8 million in funding over three years for these devices.
